The Port of Cape Preston West is declared on 2nd December 2022 through the WA Gazette SL 2022/205. The port is placed under the control and management of the Pilbara Ports Authority and will be governed in accordance with Ports Authority Act 1999 and Ports Authority regulations 2001.

The Port of Cape Preston West port waters including seabed is ascribed within the below coordinates and depicted in the attachment.

The port is monitored by Dampier VTS on channel 16 and all vessels operating or traversing the port boundary are required to notify Dampier VTS on channel 16 at time of entering and exiting the port boundary.


