Mariners are advised that the Jackson Rock buoy is now operational after being replaced with an isolated danger buoy.

The Jackson Rock buoy is in approx. position 20 ° 39.873' S, 115 ° 35.856' E (location depicted in image below).

AtoN type: Isolated danger marker.

Buoy description: Red and black spar buoy.

Day mark: Two (2) black sphere in a vertical line.

Light characteristics: FL (2) W 10s.
