<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This is a request form only. Vessels MUST NOT launch the lifeboat without permission from the Port Authority via Dampier VTS. Permission will be granted by the Port Authority via e-mail confirmation from Dampier VTS. In-water lifeboat drill requests should be received no more than 48 hours and at least 24 hrs prior to commencement of work. Permission will be granted by the Port Authority at their discretion. The in-water lifeboat drill will be approved for daylight hours only. Vessels must advise Dampier VTS (VHF Ch11) prior to commencing and on completion of any lifeboat drill. The lifeboat must not be lowered or hoisted with personnel on board. In-water lifeboat drill requests for a vessel at any berth/terminal will first require approval from the berth/terminal operator. The request must then be sent to the Port Authority for approval, along with evidence of approval from the berth/terminal operator. All requirements of the vessel's safety management system must be complied with during the in-water lifeboat drill. This document must be signed, stamped and dated by the Master.
