Permission will be granted by the Port via e-mail confirmation from VTS.</li> <li>• In-water lifeboat drill requests should be received no more than 48 hours and at least 24 hrs prior to commencement of work. Permission will be granted by Pilbara Ports at their discretion.</li> <li>• The in-water lifeboat drill will be approved for daylight hours only.</li> <li>• Vessels must advise VTS prior to commencing and on completion of any lifeboat drill:                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Dampier VTS (VHF Ch11)</li> <li>○ Ashburton VTS (VHF Ch14)</li> <li>○ Varanus Island Port Control (VHF Ch 79).</li> </ul> </li> <li>• The lifeboat must not be lowered or hoisted with personnel on board.</li> <li>• In-water lifeboat drill requests for a vessel at any berth/terminal will first require approval from the berth/terminal operator. The request must then be sent to Pilbara Ports for approval, along with evidence of approval from the berth/terminal operator.</li> <li>• All requirements of the vessel's safety management system must be complied with during the in-water lifeboat drill.</li> <li>• This document must be signed and dated by the Master.</li> <li>• The form must be sent to <a href="mailto:dampier.vts@pilbaraports.com.au">dampier.vts@pilbaraports.com.au</a>.</li> </ul>
