GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Vessels MUST NOT immobilise their engines without written permission from Port Hedland VTS
- Vessel MUST advise Port Hedland VTS (VHF Ch12) prior to commencing and on completion of engine immobilisation work
- Engine immobilisation requests should be received no more than 48 hours before commencing work
- Vessel's master has overall responsibility for the vessel during immobilisation
- Engine immobilisation requests when vessel is at berth will require terminal approval and is subject to final approval by Port of Port Hedland Harbour Master
- Engine immobilisation will not be granted for vessels berthed at Port Hedland Berth 4 (PH4)
- If engine immobilisation is required for consecutive days, individual requests for each day must be submitted
- If engine immobilisation works are carried out alongside the berth, such work **MUST** be completed at least 6 hours prior to scheduled pilot on board time
- Vessel to have due regard to predicted and prevailing weather conditions when planning engine immobilisation works
- All requirements of vessels safety management system to be complied with during engine immobilisation work
- Engine immobilisation will not be granted to vessels at anchor during a strong wind warning or impending adverse weather
- The vessel MUST advise Port Hedland VTS and the Marine Pilot of any changes to vessels ability to manoeuvre after completion of engine immobilisation works
- · Will not be granted to vessels carrying dangerous goods
