

How to lodge an AARTG Inspection with Pilbara Ports.

Pilbara Ports Class 14.4 Approved Arrangement authorises Pilbara Ports to perform rural tailgate inspections on in-scope containers (In scope includes: Dry Box, Iso tanks, Open tops, and Reefers).

Class 19.1 or 19.2 brokers, have the option to select either Biosecurity or Pilbara Ports to conduct rural tailgate inspections.
