Port users are advised that following Tropical Cyclone Mitchell, two recreational vessels have sunk in approximate positions 20°40'.06' S 116° 41.33' E and 20°40.20' S 116° 41.45' E.

The wreckage presents a hazard to surface navigation and mariners are advised to exercise extreme caution when transiting the area.


Pilbara Ports is calling for the owners of the recreational vessels to contact Dampier Vessel Traffic Service on (08) 9159 6556.
