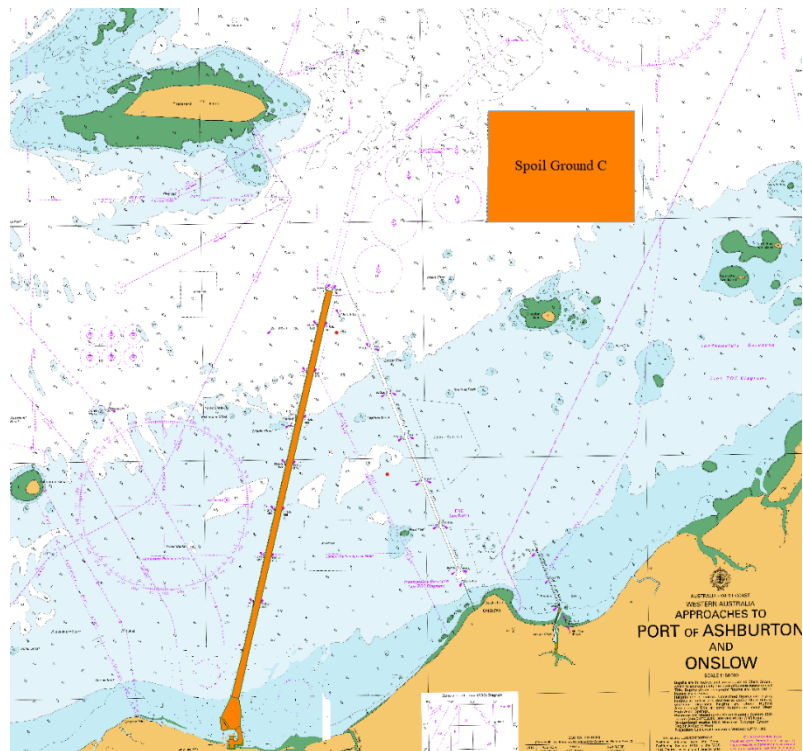
Mariners are advised that hydrographic survey operations will be conducted within the Port of Ashburton, at the locations including Ashburton Cargo Wharf (ACW), Wheatstone Marine Terminal (WMT), Ashburton Shipping Channel and the Spoil Ground C as shown on the chartlet.

The surveys will be undertaken by the survey vessel “Puriya”. The vessel will comply with the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (COLREGs) and will display the appropriate lights and shapes for a vessel engaged in survey operations.

Survey activities are scheduled to take place from 3 to 20 August 2026, during day and night.

A Sécurité broadcast will be transmitted daily by Ashburton VTS advising of the survey vessel’s operating area. Puriya will maintain a continuous listening watch on VHF Channels 14 and 16.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when operating in the vicinity of the survey area and to comply with any directions issued by VTS.
