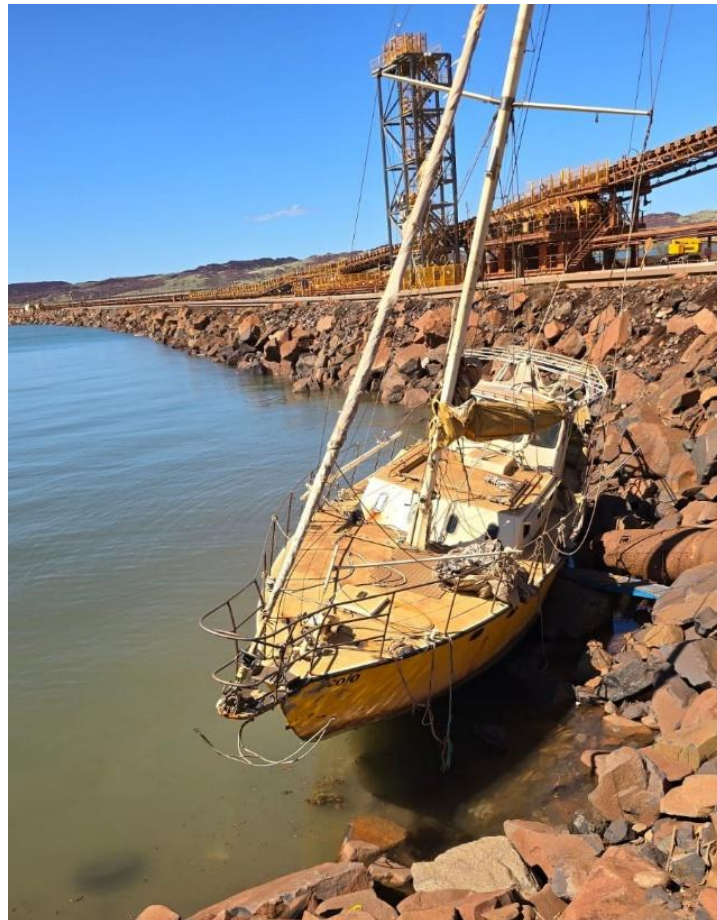
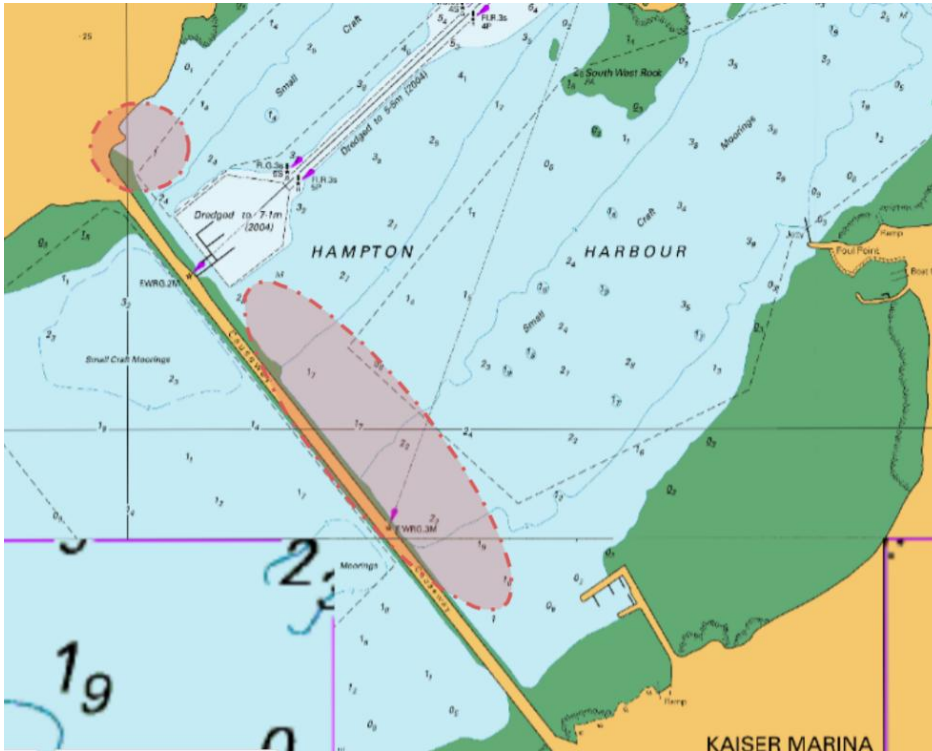
Port users are advised that, following Tropical Cyclone *Narelle*, a further two recreational vessels have sunk, and one has washed ashore at the approximate locations highlighted in the chartlet below.

Two of the wrecks are completely submerged, with only limited portions of each vessel visible above the water during low tide conditions.

These wrecks present a hazard to surface navigation. Mariners are advised to exercise extreme caution when transiting the area highlighted below.

This notice will remain in effect until the wreckage has been safely removed.
