Construction Activity – DBHF Project Area (South of DCW)

Port users are advised that construction activities are currently underway in the DBHF Project Area, located south of the Dampier Cargo Wharf (DCW). This area is designated as an active Marine Construction Zone (MCZ), as indicated below.

Access Restrictions and Vessel Movements

All vessels intending to enter the MCZ must obtain prior permission from the Primary Contractor (Clough). Unauthorized entry is strictly prohibited. While vessel movements within the MCZ do not need to be reported to VTS, any arrivals to or departures from the MCZ must be reported to Dampier VTS on VHF, along with confirmation that permission has been obtained from the Primary Contractor.

Operational Awareness

Vessels granted access must remain vigilant of ongoing construction operations and comply with all navigational and safety instructions issued by the contractor and/or Port Authority.

Permit Requirements

Permits for diving or hot works within the MCZ must be obtained directly from the Primary Contractor prior to commencing any such activities. Notification to Dampier VTS on VHF Channel 11 is required before starting and upon completion of these operations.


Port users are reminded to exercise caution and maintain clear communication with the contractor when operating near or within the project area.
