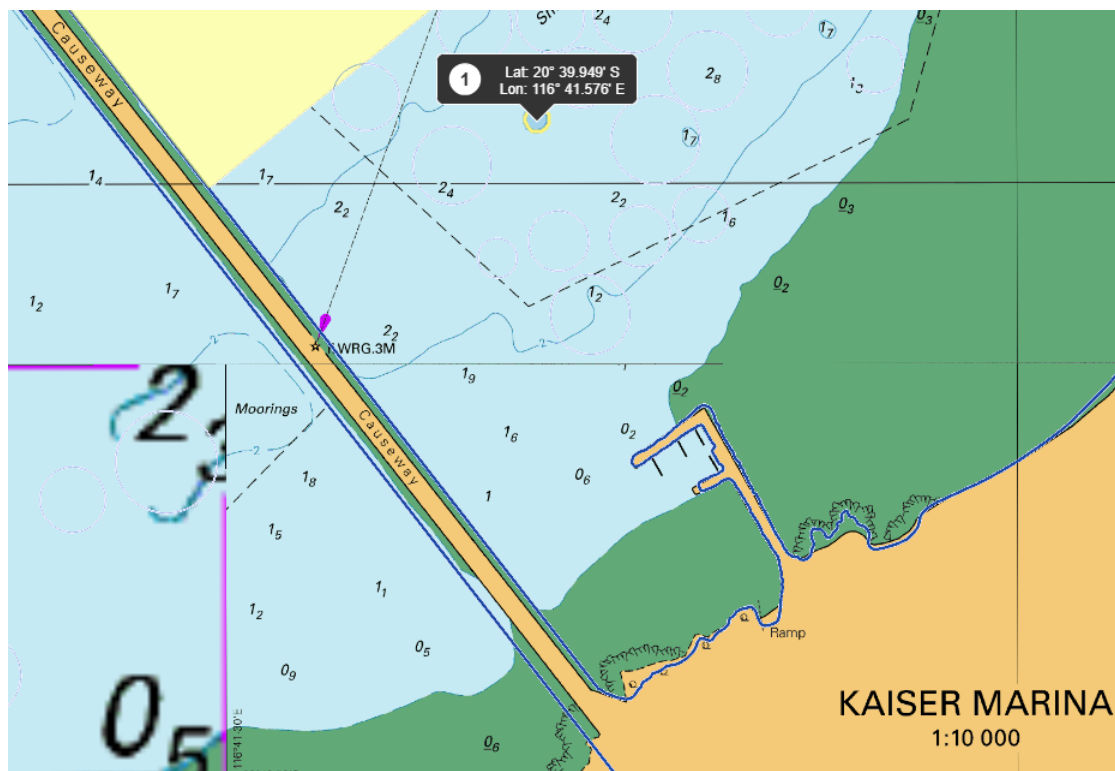

Port users are advised that a recreational vessel has sunk in approximate position 20°39'.949S 116° 41'.576E within the Hampton Harbour mooring area. The wreck is marked with a Norwegian buoy and a temporary isolated danger buoy, flashing white light in groups of two.

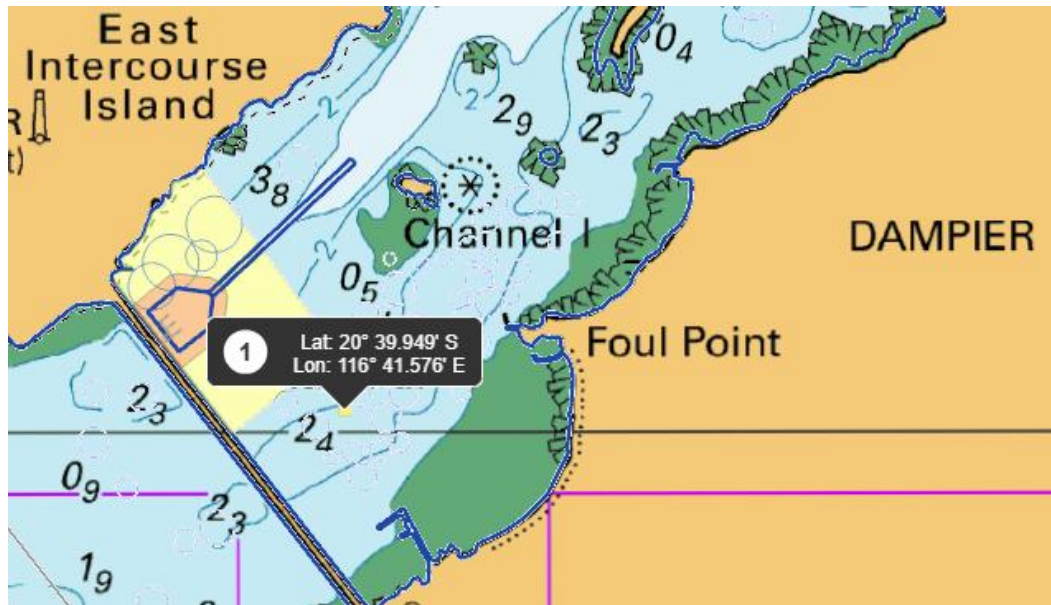
The wreckage presents a hazard to surface navigation; mariners are advised to exercise extreme caution when transiting the area.
