Port users are advised that hydrographic surveys will be conducted in the following locations (Figure 1):

- Northwest Shelf LNG Channel (Woodside Channel), including berth pockets and swing basins.
- Pluto LNG Channel, including the berth pocket and swing basin.
- King Bay Supply Base (KBSB) facility, including the KBSB Channel, berth pockets, swing basin and pilot boat pontoon area.

Survey operations will be conducted by the survey vessel **Zephyr** (Figure 2).

Zephyr will comply with the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea, 1972, as amended, and will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed for its operation. Zephyr will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 11 and 16.

The survey work will commence on **15 July 2026 and will continue for approximately 18 days.**

A Sécurité message will be broadcast daily by Dampier VTS, detailing the survey vessel's area of operation.

Mariners should navigate with caution when operating in the vicinity of the survey vessel.
