Mariners and port users are advised that from Saturday 1 August 2026, Pilbara Ports will assume operational control and governance of Marine Pilot bookings for applicable vessel movements at Common user berths including Pilbara Ports facilities, Qube facility, BMF, Toll Dampier Supply Base (TDSB) and King Bay Supply Base (KBSB) at the Port of Dampier.

From this date, Marine Pilot bookings for applicable Common user berths vessel movements must be made through the Pilbara Ports online pilot booking system. The booking system is available through the Pilbara Ports website under Quick Links on the Port of Dampier homepage.

This change supports the standardisation of pilotage services across Pilbara Ports and provides further resilience for marine pilotage operations at the Port of Dampier. This change does not affect pilotage services provided to Rio Tinto or Woodside, or arrangements for salt, iron ore or liquid natural gas (LNG) vessels.
