Pilbara Ports is advising of partial road closures of Mof Road inside the Pilbara Ports security gates to facilitate nighttime module movements in support of the Perdaman Ceres Urea project. The movements are scheduled as follows:

- **Empty SPMT: Saturday 27 December to Sunday 04 January**
- **Module (KO Drum): 1900 – 2020 Sunday 04 January**
- **Module (Distillation Tower): 1900 – 2020 Monday 05 January**
- **Module (Distillation Tower): 1900 – 2020 Tuesday 06 January**

During this period efforts will be made to flush traffic around modules at various stages to minimise the periods of traffic stops along Mof Road.

Delays may still occur during this period, and we ask all road users to follow directions from traffic management controllers/escorts. Emergency Services will have access and right of way during any partial closure and in the case of an emergency.

Please note any road closure beyond the Pilbara Ports security gate is outside of Pilbara Ports control and will be conducted under the control of a MRWA permit.

Any changes will be communicated via an updated notice.
