
LD26-006b – BLB LOWER WALKWAYS _ TEMPORARY CLOSURE (REVISED)

ATTENTION: All DBLB users

ISSUED BY: Landside Operations (Dampier)

The Terminal Operations team has authorised the temporary closure of the Dampier Bulk Liquids Berth (DBLB) lower walkways following the removal of four (4) existing dolphin ladders. This closure is required to manage fall from height (into the water) risk and to ensure safe operations until compliant ladders are installed and certified.

The planned temporary closure period is:

- **1800hrs Friday 16th January – 0600hrs Monday 26th January 2026**

The Dampier Bulk Liquids Berth (DBLB) upper and lower walkways are closed to all personnel when no vessel is alongside the berth. Dolphin access points are barricaded and tagged out with no access permitted.

The berth remains operational and available for berthing applications, subject to controlled outlined in this notice.

When a vessel is alongside the BLB during the closure period the following additional controls apply:

- **A TAMS spotter boat is to be mobilised during vessel mooring and unmooring operations to assist with Man Overboard (MOB) response.**
- **Access to lower walkways is restricted to authorised personnel only and must be managed in accordance with approved risk controls.**
- **Tie-up and let-go operations are to be conducted under agreed controls in consultation with Landside Operations and Terminal Operations.**
