
LD26/064 – Port of Dampier Mof Road truck arrestor bed temporarily closed

The Terminal Operations team has authorised the temporary closure of the Port of Dampier Mof Road truck arrestor bed. During this period the location will be under traffic management with barricading in place to facilitate an emergency braking situation if required.

The planned closure period (in stages) is noted below:

Stages 1 and 2

- 0600 Tuesday 29 September 2026 to 1800 Tuesday 13 October 2026

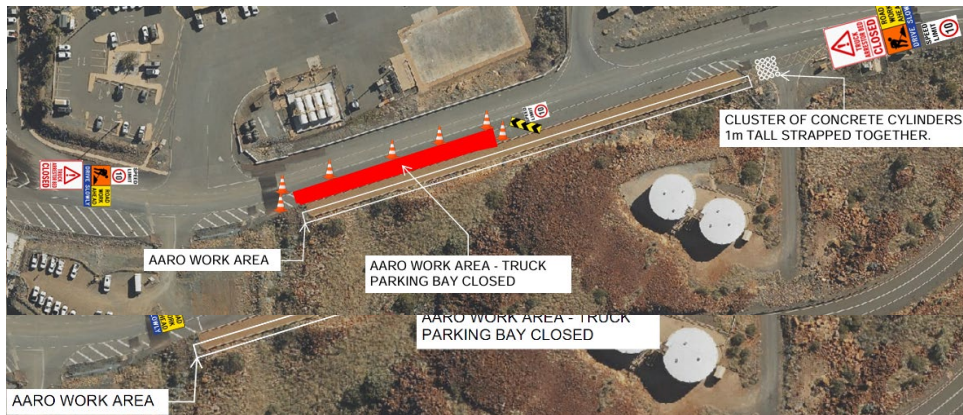
Stage 3

- 0600 Tuesday 13 October 2026 to 1800 Sunday 18 October 2026

Key Traffic Impacts

- The MOF Road Truck Arrestor Bed will be **unavailable for the duration of the works**
- During **Stages 1 and 2** all traffic lanes will remain open
- During **Stage 3** the downhill traffic lane adjacent to the arrestor bed will be partially closed as shown in the staging diagrams below
- Active traffic management will be in place during **Stage 3** and all vehicles must comply with all traffic management signage and directions provided by traffic controllers
- Reduced speed limits may apply within the work area.





Further updates will be provided should there be any changes to the maintenance schedule or closure period.
